- Work across all subjects shows fluency.
- Even levels of ascenders, descenders and capital letters.
- · Observation of all presentation rules.
- Clear, legible cursive script (joined up).
- Even spacing between words.
- Letters correctly placed on the line.
- Clear and legible writing, beginning to develop a cursive style with in and out strokes and loops on some lower case letters
- Even spaces between words.
- Corrections using a pencil line.
- All letters are in proportion and correctly orientated (i.e. no letter reversals).
- Generally upper and lower case letters are not mixed within the word.
- Ascenders and descenders are above and below the line.
- Spaces between words.
- Correct pencil grip.
- Correct formation of letters.
